

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1088

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, delete “amending ORS 809.412” and insert “creating new provisions;  
2 amending ORS 809.412; and declaring an emergency”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 10 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2008 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 419C.**

5 **“SECTION 2. If a juvenile court finds a youth to be within the jurisdiction of the court**  
6 **under ORS 419C.005 because the youth committed an act that, if committed by an adult,**  
7 **would constitute an offense that is a ground for suspension or revocation of driving privi-**  
8 **leges upon conviction of the offense, the order of the court finding the youth to be within**  
9 **the jurisdiction of the court constitutes a ground for suspension or revocation of the youth’s**  
10 **driving privileges.**

11 **“SECTION 3. ORS 809.412 is amended to read:**

12 *“809.412. [A determination by a juvenile court that a child within its jurisdiction has committed*  
13 *any act that is grounds for suspension or revocation of driving privileges under ORS 809.409 or*  
14 *809.411 is equivalent to a conviction and the juvenile court has the same authority to order suspensions*  
15 *of driving privileges and take other actions in relation to the driving privileges of the child as other*  
16 *courts have in relation to adult traffic offenders.]* **If a juvenile court finds a youth to be within the**  
17 **jurisdiction of the juvenile court under ORS 419C.005 for committing an offense that is a**  
18 **ground for suspension or revocation upon conviction under ORS 809.409, 809.411, 809.413,**  
19 **813.400 or 813.403 or any other law requiring suspension or revocation of driving privileges**  
20 **upon conviction of an offense, the juvenile court shall impose the suspension or revocation**  
21 **of driving privileges that is required upon conviction of the offense.**

22 **“SECTION 4. Section 2 of this 2008 Act and the amendments to ORS 809.412 by section**  
23 **3 of this 2008 Act apply to orders finding youths within the jurisdiction of the juvenile court**  
24 **under ORS 419C.005 entered on or after January 1, 2004.**

25 **“SECTION 5. This 2008 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
26 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2008 Act takes effect**  
27 **on its passage.”.**
