

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1089

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 29.

2 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 5 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. (1) During the 2007-2009 biennium, the Department of Human Services shall**
4 **contract with a private entity or individual to conduct an assessment and evaluation of the**
5 **community mental health care component of the mental health care delivery system in**
6 **Oregon.**

7 **“(2) The assessment conducted under subsection (1) of this section shall include but is**
8 **not limited to:**

9 **“(a) An assessment, based on existing reports to the greatest extent possible, of the gap**
10 **between the number of Oregonians in need of community mental health care and the number**
11 **who receive community mental health care;**

12 **“(b) An assessment of the investment that the Department of Human Services, the De-**
13 **partment of Corrections, the Judicial Department and local governments’ human services**
14 **and public safety systems make in both Medicaid and non-Medicaid community mental health**
15 **care, including an examination of the amount spent on community mental health care, un-**
16 **reimbursed care and charity care; and**

17 **“(c) A catalog of the information that agencies and local governments use to evaluate the**
18 **performance of mental health organizations described in ORS 414.736 (4) and providers of**
19 **community mental health care, including:**

20 **“(A) The data collected and the performance measures and outcomes that are tracked**
21 **by each agency and local government; and**

22 **“(B) The ability of the data systems to collect data that is timely and to communicate**
23 **efficiently.**

24 **“(3) The assessment conducted under subsection (2)(a) of this section must include a**
25 **separate analysis of the gap between the demand for community mental health care by vet-**
26 **erans returning from tours in Iraq, Afghanistan and other hostile fire areas and the com-**
27 **munity mental health care that is provided at United States Department of Veterans Affairs**
28 **facilities.**

29 **“(4) The evaluation conducted under subsection (1) of this section must contain:**

30 **“(a) An analysis of the strengths and weaknesses in the state community mental health**
31 **care delivery system; and**

32 **“(b) An overview of future community mental health care delivery system needs, with**
33 **an emphasis on collaboration between agencies and systems to reduce demand for institu-**
34 **tional care.**

35 **“(5) The Department of Human Services shall provide a written report, in accordance**

1 with the provisions of ORS 192.235 to 192.245, to the Senate Interim Committee on Health
2 and Human Services and the House Interim Committee on Health Care no later than October
3 1, 2008, of the results of:

4 “(a) The assessment and evaluation conducted under subsection (1) of this 2008 Act;

5 “(b) The department’s study of children’s wrap-around services; and

6 “(c) The analysis of alcohol and drug treatment services that is currently underway by
7 the department in collaboration with the Department of Corrections.”

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
