

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 1093

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, after the first semicolon delete the rest of the  
2 line and insert “amending sections 5, 9, 24 and 25, chapter 697, Oregon Laws”.

3 In line 3, after the first semicolon insert “appropriating money;”.

4 Delete lines 5 through 14.

5 In line 15, delete “3” and insert “1”.

6 On page 2, line 15, delete “4” and insert “2”.

7 On page 6, after line 8, insert:

8 “**SECTION 3.** Section 24, chapter 697, Oregon Laws 2007, is amended to read:

9 “**Sec. 24.** *[(1) There is appropriated to the Oregon Health Fund Board, for the biennium beginning*  
10 *July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1 for the purpose of carrying out the provisions*  
11 *of sections 2 to 13 of this 2007 Act.]*

12 “[*(2)*] Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$1 is established for  
13 the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,  
14 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal  
15 funds, collected or received by the Oregon Health Fund Board.

16 “**SECTION 4.** Section 25, chapter 697, Oregon Laws 2007, is amended to read:

17 “**Sec. 25.** (1) There is appropriated to the [*Department of Human Services*] **Oregon Health Fund**  
18 **Board**, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of  
19 [*\$1,215,350*] **\$1,215,351** for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of sections 2 to 13, **chapter**  
20 **697, Oregon Laws 2007** [*of this 2007 Act*].

21 “[*(2)*] Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$671,971 is established  
22 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal  
23 funds collected or received by the [*Department of Human Services*] **Oregon Health Fund Board**, for  
24 the purpose of carrying out sections 2 to 13, **chapter 697, Oregon Laws 2007** [*of this 2007 Act*].”.
