SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Requires court to impose minimum \$500,000 security release amount for persons charged with manufacture, delivery or possession of methamphetamine under certain circumstances.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 2 Relating to methamphetamine. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. When a defendant is charged with an offense described in ORS 475.886, 475.888, 475.890, 475.892, 475.894 or 475.906, the court may not release the defendant on any 5 form of release other than a security release and shall set a security amount of not less than 6 7 \$500,000 if the offense is alleged to constitute: 8 (1) The delivery or manufacture of substantial quantities of methamphetamine as that phrase is described in ORS 475.900 (1)(a); 9 10 (2) A commercial drug offense under ORS 475.900 (1)(b); or (3) The possession of 10 grams or more of a mixture or substance containing a detectable 11 amount of methamphetamine under ORS 475.900 (2)(b). 12 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2008 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 135.230 to 13 135.290. 14
