

Senate Bill 5556

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Adjusts limitations on expenditures by various agencies.
Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on**
5 **expenditures for community support established by section 2 (3), chapter 747, Oregon Laws**
6 **2007, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses**
7 **from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and reimbursements**
8 **from federal service agreements, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described**
9 **in section 2, chapter 747, Oregon Laws 2007, collected or received by the Oregon Military**
10 **Department, is increased by \$112,462 for reimbursement of firefighting costs incurred during**
11 **the 2007 fire season.**

12 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on**
13 **expenditures for emergency management established by section 3 (3), chapter 747, Oregon**
14 **Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of**
15 **expenses from federal funds, other than those described in section 2, chapter 747, Oregon**
16 **Laws 2007, collected or received by the Oregon Military Department, is increased by**
17 **\$17,500,000 for pre-disaster mitigation grants and chemical stockpile emergency preparedness**
18 **program grants.**

19 **SECTION 3. (1) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on**
20 **expenditures for emergency management established by section 2 (5), chapter 747, Oregon**
21 **Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of**
22 **expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and re-**
23 **imbursements from federal service agreements, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds**
24 **not described in section 2, chapter 747, Oregon Laws 2007, collected or received by the**
25 **Oregon Military Department, is decreased by \$3,201,465.**

26 **(2) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures**
27 **for emergency management established by section 3 (3), chapter 747, Oregon Laws 2007, for**
28 **the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from**
29 **federal funds, other than those described in section 2, chapter 747, Oregon Laws 2007, col-**
30 **lected or received by the Oregon Military Department, is increased by \$3,201,465 for expend-**

1 iture of United States Department of Homeland Security grants other than those described
2 in section 4 of this 2008 Act.

3 **SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
4 expenditures for emergency management established by section 3 (3), chapter 747, Oregon
5 Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of
6 expenses from federal funds, other than those described in section 2, chapter 747, Oregon
7 Laws 2007, collected or received by the Oregon Military Department, is increased by
8 \$11,800,000 for expenditure of United States Department of Homeland Security grants for
9 public assistance related to disaster relief and post-disaster hazard mitigation grants.

10 **SECTION 5.** (1) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
11 expenditures for debt service established by section 2 (7), chapter 73, Oregon Laws 2007, for
12 the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from
13 fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds
14 and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Department of Administrative Ser-
15 vices, is increased by \$256,374 for renovations to the State Office Building in Eugene.

16 (2) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures
17 for debt service established by section 2 (7), chapter 73, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium
18 beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or
19 other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal
20 funds, collected or received by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, is in-
21 creased by \$178,302 for conversion of data center spaces.

22 (3) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures
23 for capital improvements established by section 2 (4), chapter 73, Oregon Laws 2007, for the
24 biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,
25 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and
26 federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services,
27 is increased by \$567,000 for projects on the Capitol Mall.

28 **SECTION 6.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
29 expenditures for operations established by section 4 (1), chapter 699, Oregon Laws 2007, for
30 the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from
31 federal funds, other than those described in sections 5 and 10, chapter 699, Oregon Laws 2007,
32 collected or received by the Department of Education, is increased by \$3,300,000 for a state-
33 wide longitudinal data systems grant.

34 **SECTION 7.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
35 expenditures for the Oregon Wetlands Mitigation Bank Revolving Fund Account established
36 by section 2 (5), chapter 107, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as
37 the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including
38 Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received
39 by the Department of State Lands, is increased by \$1,500,000 for wetland mitigation projects.

40 **SECTION 8.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
41 expenditures established by section 5, chapter 388, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium be-
42 ginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or
43 other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, except those deposited in the Multistate
44 Tax Commission Revolving Account and the Senior Property Tax Deferral Revolving Ac-
45 count, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Department

1 of Revenue, is increased by \$1,317,835 for the administrative cost of calculating and issuing
2 refund checks as required by ORS 291.349.

3 **SECTION 9.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
4 expenditures established by section 2, chapter 728, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium be-
5 ginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or
6 other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal
7 funds, collected or received by the Department of Justice, is increased by \$343,596 for
8 Oregon's Terrorism Intelligence Threat Assessment Network Fusion Center.

9 **SECTION 10.** This 2008 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
10 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2008 Act takes effect
11 on its passage.

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
