Measure Description:

Changes the resident district of public charter school students who receive special education and related services to the school district in which the public charter school is located. Requires resident district to identify and evaluate students in charter schools that need special education services. First applies to students who attend public charter schools that enter into a charter or renew a charter after January 1, 2010.

Impact Explanation:

State School Fund dollars will initially shift from the resident district to the district where a charter school with special education students is located if the charter school is outside the resident district. The legislation is prospective so that the number of students and school districts affected depends on future special education students enrolled in charter schools and those in charter schools when the charter is renewed with school districts.
