## **Measure Description:**

Requires the Department of Education to grant a 10<sup>th</sup> grade assessment waiver to eligible school districts that request a waiver. Allows a school district with a waiver to contract with a testing entity different from that used by the Department. Makes a district eligible for waiver if the district had a contract in 2007-08 with their entity and meets other criteria. Requires the Department to reimburse the waiver districts for assessment costs out of the \$550,000 from the State School Fund that is otherwise allocated to ESDs.

## **Impact Explanation:**

The Department of Education estimates that up to 10 districts with about 7,500 10<sup>th</sup> grade students could qualify for waivers. The Department assessment costs would be about \$85,000 per year that would otherwise be distributed to ESDs.
