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**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Requires Oregon State Lottery Commission (Commission), after end of biennium, to determine actual amount of money in Administrative Services Economic Development Fund (Fund) that was available for that biennium. States that if actual amount of money available in the Fund exceeds amounts projected in budget report prepared by Commission to be available for allocation from Fund for that biennium, there is allocated from the Fund to the school capital matching sub-account, an amount equal to that excess. Provides amount allocated may not include portions of amount that are required to be transferred to the Education Stability Fund, school capital matching sub-account, or parks and natural resources fund. Applies to biennia beginning on or after July 1, 2007. Declares an emergency; effective upon passage.

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** House Bill 2012 allows the transfer of money from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the school capital matching sub-account if actual sums in the fund exceed the amount projected in the budget report prepared by the Lottery Commission. Money deposited in the school capital matching sub-account can be used to help districts with items such as deteriorating infrastructure.
