WHAT THE BILL DOES: Corrects grammar, syntax and references in Oregon tax laws. Repeals obsolete statutes. Has no impact on current tax policy.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Nature of biennial revisers bill.
- Deletion of reference to MIAs from Vietnam War era.
- Deletion of obsolete reference to underground tanks.
- Impact of 2007 regular session legislation.

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS: Restores reference to MIAs from Vietnam War era. Corrects faulty reference in 2007 statute modifying college savings network account.

BACKGROUND: During each interim, Legislative Counsel prepares the "revisers bill" which is designed to update and make corrections to Oregon tax statutes. HB 2065 is the 2009 version of that effort. In preparing this bill Legislative Counsel strives to make sure the bill does not have an impact on current tax policy.
