WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Allows Department of State Lands to impose civil penalties for certain uses of certain state lands. Declares an emergency; effective upon passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Frequency of trespassing cases
- · Civil penalties would be a less cumbersome way to enforce and deter trespassing
- Already have authority for waterway users

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: The Department of State Lands currently has authority to assess civil penalties for unauthorized uses of state-owned waterways, but not corresponding uplands. Civil penalties are an effective means to deter such uses and will also generate revenue for the Common School Fund.
