WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Increases or establishes certain fees related to hunting, angling and commercial fishing. Extends and increases certain surcharges. Creates Fish Passage Fund.

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: Resolves conflicts.

BACKGROUND: The mission of the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife is "to protect and enhance Oregon's fish and wildlife and their habitats for use and enjoyment by present and future generations." The department's 2009-2011 budget proposal includes increases in recreational and commercial fees to maintain agency programs and to provide some additional hunting and fishing opportunities.
