WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Increases start card fee from \$125 to \$225. Effective July 1, 2009.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

Decreasing number of wells drilled due to economic conditions

- Agency work funded by start card fees
- Specific statutory limitations on use of start card revenues

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** Makes new fee level effective July 1, 2009.

**BACKGROUND:** ORS 537.762 requires a well driller to submit a report to the Water Resources Commission before beginning any work on a well. This report is called a "start card." The statute requires a fee to be submitted with a start card and directs that such fees are used to pay the cost of well inspections. The start card fee was last increased in 2003.
