WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Adds chiropractic physicians and the State Board of Chiropractic Examiners to insurance provisions relating to notice of professional negligence claims to health professional regulatory boards and to subsequent actions of the boards.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Current malpractice insurers' claims reporting
- Information being posted on the Board of Chiropractic Examiners' web page
- Transparency for patients on disciplinary actions
- Board's strategic plan

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Currently, ORS 742.400 is the medical malpractice insurance statute. The statute requires malpractice insurers to report claims to licensing boards for medical doctors, dentists, optometrists, nurse practitioners and naturopaths. Chiropractic physicians are not identified.
