WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Deletes the original bill, increases the homestead exemption to \$40,000-\$50,000 and declares an emergency.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Greater protection for Oregon homeowners facing bankruptcy
- Creditors want to choose what exemptions are taken
- Federal exemptions tied to consumer price index
- Equality for long term Oregon residents
- Bankruptcy abuse

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: Deletes the original bill, increases the homestead exemption to \$40,000-\$50,000 and declares an emergency.

BACKGROUND: HB 2306A increases the homestead exemption homeowners may claim when filing for bankruptcy. Under current law, a single homeowner can claim \$30,000 exempt pursuant to ORS 18.395. Non-homeowners may not claim exemptions in property in lieu of the homestead. Under this measure, the homestead exemption is increased to \$40,000-\$50,000.
