WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Allows petitioner or party to request court to modify certain Family Abuse Protection Act (FAPA) orders for good cause. Applies retroactively to all orders issued under FAPA.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

Provisions of the measure.

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: ORS 107.718 allows a party to request modification of custody or parenting time. HB 2310 A allows a petitioner or a party to request a modification on other terms of the order under ORS 107.718 (1)(b),(g) or (i). (Requiring respondent to move from petitioner's residence, requiring respondent to be restrained from entering, or requiring respondent to have no contact with petitioner.) A party may also request modification of temporary custody of the children to petitioner. (ORS 107.718(1)(a)).
