**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Allows law enforcement agency to remove hidden compartment from a vehicle that has been forfeited and to be reimbursed for expense associated with removal out of proceeds of selling the vehicle. Defines "motor vehicle with a hidden compartment" as one modified to hide contents intended to be used to facilitate a crime.

## EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** When a vehicle with a hidden compartment is forfeited, law enforcement agencies remove the compartment before selling or disposing of the vehicle. HB 2403A covers both civil and criminal forfeiture and provides a process for law enforcement agencies to recoup the cost of removing these compartments.
