EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: The pesticide use reporting system was originally passed by the 1999 Oregon Legislature. The program requires all persons applying pesticides in the course of business, for a government agency or in a public place, to annually report that use online. A pesticide is any chemical used to kill, repel or mitigate a pest, including insecticides, herbicides, fungicides, rodenticides and others.
