WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Prohibits agreements for transfer of real property that impose fees or other consideration upon future transfers of the property. Declares an emergency, effective upon passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Prohibition of transfer fees
- Prohibition of imposition of servitude
- Award of attorney fees
- Exceptions for enforceable contracts, affordable housing and homeowners associations

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: Removes provision to award attorney fees and clarifies exemptions for public housing, homeowners associations, and timeshares.

BACKGROUND: Private transfer fees written into real estate contracts have increased in many states. HB 2481-A prohibits this practice in Oregon.
