WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Requires a driver license or identity card issued by the Department of Transportation to indicate a person may not buy alcohol if the person has two prior convictions for driving under the influence of intoxicants (DUII). Requires licensees and permittees of Oregon Liquor Control Commission to check identification prior to selling or serving alcohol. Applies only to bars and taverns and begins on January 1, 2011.
