**WHAT THE BILL DOES:** Clarifies that property tax apportionment provisions in ORS 368.710 apply to local option taxes imposed by county for road improvement, repair or maintenance.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

Clarification of apportionment

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS:** No amendments

**BACKGROUND:** ORS 368.705 to 368.722 spell out use and apportionment of county road funds raised by local option taxes. This bill is intended to clarify that a countywide local option tax imposed by a county for road improvement, repair or maintenance, not the local option taxes imposed in general, will be subject to apportionment and compression dictated in ORS 368.710.
