WHAT THE BILL DOES: Clarifies that the property tax apportionment provisions in ORS 368.710 apply only to a countywide local option tax imposed by a county for road improvement, repair or maintenance.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Need for clarification

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS: None

BACKGROUND: ORS 368.705 to 368.722 spell out use and apportionment of county road funds raised by local option taxes. This bill is intended to clarify that a countywide local option tax imposed by a county only for road improvement, repair or maintenance, not the local option taxes imposed in general, will be subject to the apportionment provisions dictated in ORS 368.710.
