WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Allows the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to apply for and receive gifts and grants and to award grants. Removes the provision concerning entering into contracts without following Department of Administrative Services (DAS) procedures. Allows the commission to adopt rules setting forth how it will apply for and receive grants.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

Clarifies that the commission may receive grants and gifts, and award grants

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: Removes the provision concerning entering into contracts without following (DAS) procedures. Allows the commission to adopt rules setting forth how it will apply for and receive grants.

BACKGROUND: The purpose of the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission is to improve the effectiveness and efficiency of state and local criminal justice systems by providing a centralized and impartial forum for statewide policy development and planning. Its primary duty is, among other things, to develop a long-range plan for a coordinated state criminal justice system that encompasses public safety, offender accountability, crime reduction and prevention and offender treatment and rehabilitation. It is subject to purchasing goods and services pursuant to the rules and regulations of DAS.
