**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Prohibits supplies, equipment and apparatus furnished to schools from being used to provide services related to printing, binding or graphic arts to the public or any state or local government or political subdivision. Provides that the prohibition applies only to printing, binding or graphic arts services provided on or after the effective date of the measure. Provides that the prohibition does not apply to contracts for printing, binding or graphic arts services entered into prior to the effective date of the measure, but prohibits the renewal of a contract after the effective date of the measure.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Need to refer this bill to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.
