**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Clarifies the definition of parole and probation officers for the purpose of carrying firearms. Provides that retired parole and probation officers are exempt from being prosecuted for unlawful possession of a firearm. Declares emergency, effective upon passage.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Interpretation by two counties
- Determining who is retired

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** Adding "or" into the current statute is intended to clarify that probation officers may carry a firearm prior to having one year of experience on the job. In addition, HB 2789A adds *retired* parole and probation officers to the list of people who are exempt from ORS.166.250.
