WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Adds one nonmanagement parole and probation officer to the Board on Public Safety Standards and Training. Removes the Department of Forestry position. Adds two nonmanagement positions to the Corrections Policy Committee and the Police Policy Committee. Requires notice of denial or revocation following policy committee vote. Requires review by policy committee if the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training proposes to amend a proposed order issued by an Administrative Law Judge.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

• Removal of Department of Forestry position

## **EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** The Department of Public Safety Standards and Training is governed by a 24-member Board on Public Safety Standards and Training, and six discipline-specific, public safety policy committees. The board and committees make the department's rules, provide input into, and make decisions regarding, training standards and certification requirements, review individual certification cases, and set agency goals. The board and committees meet quarterly. HB 2790A adds one person, a nonmanagement parole and probation officer, to the board, removes the Department of Forestry position, and restructures some of the policy committees. In addition, HB 2790A speeds up the revocation process and requires policy committee review of certain contested case decisions.
