**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Extends metropolitan service district (district) jurisdiction to urban growth boundary automatically upon expansion of the urban growth boundary (UGB).

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Legislation applies to boundary changes that occur after the Act takes effect
- Residents of land added to the UGB, but outside the district, are not allowed to vote in Metro elections

## **EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** Currently, two separate processes must be undertaken to govern planning and the provision of services: the process to expand an urban growth boundary and then a separate process to expand the jurisdiction of the service district to match that boundary. House Bill 3043A allows both to be accomplished in one process.
