WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Requires the Department of Transportation (Department) to design a 'Keep Kids Safe' registration plate in consultation with the State Commission on Children and Families (Commission). Provides that, in addition to any other fee authorized by law, upon issuance of a 'Keep Kids Safe' registration plate, and upon renewal of the registration of a vehicle that has such plates, the Department shall collect a surcharge of \$16 per year of registration. Directs net proceeds of the surcharge collected by the department to be deposited in the commission's account for child abuse prevention programs. Requires quarterly deposits in the account.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:
