EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Unless a new owner registers a transferred vehicle, the previous owner may still be liable for costs of towing and storage. By allowing the department to issue a receipt to the transferor, House Bill 3151A provides the consumer with proof of the transfer and a potential defense against claims of liability.
