WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Provides that a juvenile director oversight committee may assume the duties and powers of a “director” of the juvenile department under certain circumstances. Allows for delegation of committee duties to subordinate officers and employees. Deletes the provision allowing the oversight committee to delegate administrative duties or functions to subordinate staff or employees.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: Amendment deletes the provision allowing the oversight committee to delegate administrative duties or functions to subordinate staff or employees.

BACKGROUND: Under current law, one person is to be designated by an appointed authority as the director of the juvenile department in any county. The director’s duties include overseeing juvenile detention facilities maintained by the county and supervision of the staff of the juvenile department and detention facilities.
