**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Allows closely-related person to effectuate insurance for funeral expenses of adult, provided person has lawful, substantial interest in life, health and safety of adult.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- · Vagueness of current law
- Insurance company requirement to obtain power of attorney

## **EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** Currently, most insurance companies require a person to obtain power of attorney before purchasing a funeral arrangement insurance plan for a family member. House Bill 3184A would allow a person to purchase a plan without power of attorney provided the person has a lawful, substantial interest in the well-being of the adult for whom the plan is purchased.
