**WHAT THE BILL DOES:** Changes requirements for Oregon State Lottery Commission budget report to Governor, Legislative Fiscal Officer and Legislative Revenue Officer from biennial to annual.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- The biennial budget reports verses the annual process that the lottery practices currently.
- How lottery budget process relates to the state budget.

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS:** No Amendments

**BACKGROUND:**

The Oregon Sate lottery is required to prepare a biennial budget report to pace the process of other state budgets. This bill changes the requirement to an annual report.

Biennial requirements that go away are the November 10 of even year submission, and stay confidential until December 1.
