WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Provides that a person possessing a permit or license issued by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives to possess, store or manufacture explosives, does not have to register with the State Fire Marshal. Clarifies that a person driving a vehicle transporting explosives must either possess a certificate issued by the State of Oregon, or have complied with bureau requirements.

## **EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** The State Fire Marshal, in conjunction with the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives regulates the possession, storage and manufacture of explosives in Oregon. Senate Bill 89A provides that if a person has satisfied federal requirements and hold a permit for these items, then the person does not have to separately register with the State Fire Marshal.
