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**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Exempts persons possessing a permit or license issued by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives to possess, store or manufacture explosives from the requirement to register with the State Fire Marshal. Clarifies that a person driving a vehicle transporting explosives must either possess a certificate issued by the State of Oregon, or has complied with the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives requirements.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Streamline the regulator process

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** Clarifies that a person driving a vehicle transporting explosives must either possess a certificate issued by the State of Oregon or has complied with the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives requirements.

**BACKGROUND:** The State Fire Marshal, in conjunction with the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives regulates the possession, storage and manufacture of explosives in Oregon. SB 89 A would reduce the requirement that a person has to meet the requirements of the State Fire Marshal if that person has already satisfied federal requirements.
