WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Requires Department of Corrections, beginning in 2012 and every six years thereafter, to conduct study to determine actual costs incurred by each county in providing management, support services, supervision and sanctioning of felons under the supervision of county.

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Pursuant to ORS 423.478(2), Oregon's counties, in partnership with the Oregon Department of Corrections, have responsibility for community-based supervision and sanctioning of offenders who are convicted of felonies and who are on parole, probation, post-prison supervision or sentenced to less than 12 months incarceration. The State of Oregon reimburses the counties for providing these services.
