**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Adds State Treasurer and Secretary of State to State Board of Education as non-voting members.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** Under current statute, the State Board of Education consists of seven members appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate for four-year terms. Membership must include at least one person from each congressional district and two members from the state at large. The board currently has five advisors.
