WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Adds State Treasurer and Secretary of State to State Board of Education as nonvoting, ex officio members of board.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Under current statute, the State Board of Education consists of seven members appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate for four-year terms. Membership must include at least one person from each congressional district and two members from the state at large. The board currently has five advisors.
