**BACKGROUND:** The Oregon State Interoperability Executive Council was created by Executive Order 02-17 in 2002 and is charged with improving and developing interoperable public safety communication systems in Oregon. The council's mission is to develop recommendations for policy and guidelines, identify technology and standards, and coordinate intergovernmental resources to facilitate statewide wireless communications interoperability with emphasis on public safety.
