WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Requires the Department of Education to grant a 10th grade assessment waiver to eligible school districts during the 2009-11 biennium. Makes a district eligible if the district had an assessment contract with an entity different from that used by the state in 2007-08 and the entity met the conditions for administering an assessment test in the most recent year and plans do so again in the waiver year. Specifies that such a waiver is valid for one school year and eligible for renewal. Requires the Department to reimburse the waiver districts for assessment costs out of the \$550,000 from the State School Fund that is otherwise allocated to education service districts. Repeals granting waivers on June 30, 2011. Takes effect July 1, 2009.

- Impact of existing law on school districts using alternative assessment instrument.

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Legislation in the 2008 Supplemental Session granted district waiver authority for 2008-09 without any specific funding.
