**BACKGROUND:** Wes Lematta founded Columbia Helicopters, Inc. in April 1957. Columbia pioneered the technique of Direct Visual Operational Control (DVOC), now the accepted method of safe, precision cargo placement worldwide. Columbia has become the world leader in helicopter yarding of timber, known as "helilogging."

Today, Columbia Helicopters, headquartered at Aurora State Airport, has a fleet of 30 aircraft and approximately 800 employees.
