**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Commemorates Legislative Fiscal Office (LFO) for 50 years of service.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- LFO's valuable assistance to legislators in balancing the budget
- Desire to honor an "extraordinary" staff whose work is often behind the scenes
- Appreciation of LFO's tireless efforts, often working long hours and with great precision

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** The Legislative Fiscal Office was founded in 1959, to "ascertain facts and make recommendations" about the Governor's budget, state expenditures and fiscal implementations. Today it operates with a staff of over 25 analysts and support team members. Seven Legislative Fiscal Officers have served the Legislature, from Kenneth Bragg, the first officer, to Ken Rocco, the current officer.
