**Summary of Capital Construction and Information Technology Subcommittee Action**

Senate Bill 443 establishes the Oregon Educator Professional Development Commission for the purpose of providing statewide collaborative leadership for prekindergarten through post-secondary education in the area of school improvement. The primary activities of the Commission include:

1. Developing and maintaining a public website for posting and sharing professional development opportunities; and
2. Assisting local school districts in developing professional development plans to meet school improvement objectives.

The amount of \$130,000 is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Education for carrying out the purposes of the Oregon Educator Professional Development Commission.
