**EFFECTIVE DATE:** The bill includes an emergency clause and is effective on passage

**LOCAL GOVERNMENT MANDATE:** This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

**ANALYSIS:** HB 2506 increases the number of public members on health regulatory boards.

The fiscal impact of this bill depends on the number of public members currently on health regulatory boards. Most agencies estimate a minimal fiscal impact from the requirements of this bill. Many of these boards have limited budget resources, and may need to seek an expenditure limitation increase from the Emergency Board or supplemental session of the Legislature if the requirements of the bill results in additional costs.
