EFFECTIVE DATE: July 1, 2009.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT MANDATE: This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

ANALYSIS: The bill appropriates \$250,000 General Fund to the Department of Agriculture for the purpose of developing a business plan to produce energy from agricultural sources.

The Department of Agriculture anticipates contracting out the research and related work required to develop the business plan identified in the bill. Contract administration and management will be assumed with existing resources.
