LOCAL GOVERNMENT MANDATE: This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

ANALYSIS: This measure specifies that provider base rates and add-on payments are included as mandatory subjects of collective bargaining for adult foster care home providers.

The fiscal impact to the Department of Human Services if this bill is enacted is indeterminate at this time. Due to the complex nature of the collective bargaining process, the fiscal impact of including provider base rates and add-on payments cannot be projected at this time.

The Department of Administrative Services (DAS) expects minimal costs related to assisting the Department of Human Services in the collective bargaining process. DAS notes the bill would likely increase its collective bargaining workload, but this would likely be handled by existing staff.
