EFFECTIVE DATE: January 1, 2010

GOVERNOR'S BUDGET: This bill is anticipated by the Governor's recommended budget.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT MANDATE: This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

ANALYSIS: This bill will increase license, renewal and per-customer charges for nonretail fuel facilities. The fees will be increased in January 2010 and July 2011. The fee increase is necessary for the continued operation of the program in the State Fire Marshalls Office that inspects and regulates the industry. It is anticipated that passage of this bill may require additional limitation being given to the programs budget.
