**EFFECTIVE DATE:** January 1, 2010

**GOVERNOR'S BUDGET:** This bill is anticipated by the Governor's recommended budget.

**LOCAL GOVERNMENT MANDATE:** This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

**ANALYSIS:** This will increase the fees paid by individuals and businesses that install or service propane tanks. The fees will be increased in two phases beginning in January 2010 and again in July 2011. The most recent fee increase was instituted in 2003. The fee increases proposed by SB 91 are outlined below. It is anticipated that this bill may require additional limitation added to the budget of the Oregon State Police.
