SUBJECT: Authorizes the Office of Emergency Management in the Oregon Military Department to accept donations from public and private sources to be deposited in the Oregon Pre-Disaster Mitigation Fund to disburse for the purpose of strengthening security in and around facilities of the Jewish Federation of Greater Portland.

EFFECTIVE DATE: July 1, 2009

LOCAL GOVERNMENT MANDATE: This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

ANALYSIS: This measure authorizes the Office of Emergency Management in the Oregon Military Department to receive gifts, grants, bequests endowments and donations, in amounts not less than \$250,000, from public and private sources. Moneys received must be deposited in the Oregon Pre-Disaster Mitigation Fund and are continuously appropriated to OMD to disburse for the purpose of strengthening security in and around facilities of the Jewish Federation of Greater Portland. OMD may agree to conditions placed on the use of the moneys. OMD will be required to develop administrative rules to ensure compliance to the provisions of this bill.

The Oregon Military Department reports an indeterminate but minimal impact on the Department if this bill passes. Although grants to secure vulnerable non-profit organizations that could be targets of violence are available from the United States Department of Homeland Security, OMD is unable to determine, at this time, the amount of funds that could be raised from the specified sources, especially given the \$250,000 threshold stipulated in this bill.
