Measure Description: Eliminates the Employment Department component of the JOBS Plus program. Transfers the balance of moneys in Oregon Jobs Plus Unemployment Wage Fund to General Fund.

Impact Explanation: The Employment Department Jobs Plus program has not been funded since 2005. Currently the Department of Human Services houses the only operable Jobs Plus program. This bill eliminates the Employment Department component of the JOBS Plus program, and transfers any unexpended balances remaining in Oregon Jobs Plus Unemployment Wage Fund to General Fund on January 1, 2010.
