

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2011

1 Delete lines 4 through 13 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) The State Board of Higher Education shall direct each state institution**
3 **of higher education to waive tuition for any course audited by an Oregon resident 65 years**
4 **of age or older if:**

5 **“(a) Space is available in the course for additional students to register after degree-**
6 **seeking students have registered;**

7 **“(b) The department in which the course is being taught approves; and**

8 **“(c) The auditing student is registered for eight credits or fewer per term.**

9 **“(2) A state institution of higher education may charge the student attending under**
10 **subsection (1) of this section fees associated with the course being audited.**

11 **“(3) A state institution of higher education may develop rules for implementation of this**
12 **section, including rules relating to registration, admission and fees.**

13 **“SECTION 2. (1) The board of education of a community college district shall direct each**
14 **community college under its control to waive tuition for any course audited by an Oregon**
15 **resident 65 years of age or older if:**

16 **“(a) Space is available in the course for additional students to register after tuition-**
17 **paying students have registered;**

18 **“(b) The department in which the course is being taught approves;**

19 **“(c) The auditing student is registered for eight credits or fewer per term; and**

20 **“(d) The course is a lower-division collegiate course.**

21 **“(2) Each community college may charge the student attending under subsection (1) of**
22 **this section fees associated with the course being audited.**

23 **“(3) The board of education of a community college district may develop rules for imple-**
24 **mentation of this section, including rules relating to registration, admission and fees.”.**
