

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2013

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, after “money;” insert “limiting
2 expenditures;”.

3 On page 2, after line 31, insert:

4 “(13) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services may accept contributions of moneys
5 and assistance from the United States Government or its agencies or from any other source, public
6 or private, and agree to conditions placed on the moneys not inconsistent with the duties of the task
7 force. All moneys received by the department under this subsection shall be deposited into the
8 Oregon School Facilities Task Force Fund established under section 4 of this 2009 Act to be used
9 for the purposes of carrying out the duties of the task force.

10 “(14) The task force shall submit a report and make recommendations to the first special session
11 of the Legislative Assembly occurring in 2010 or, if there is not a special session, to the regular
12 session of the Legislative Assembly occurring in 2011. The report shall include multiple options for
13 conducting the study described in section 2 of this 2009 Act. The options must vary in cost and
14 scope.”.

15 In line 32, after “(1)” insert “Following the submission of the report described in section 1 (14)
16 of this 2009 Act and based on the amount of available funding.”.

17 On page 3, delete lines 21 through 24 and insert:

18 “**SECTION 4. The Oregon School Facilities Task Force Fund is established in the State
19 Treasury, separate and distinct from the General Fund. Interest earned by the Oregon
20 School Facilities Task Force Fund shall be credited to the fund. All moneys in the Oregon
21 School Facilities Task Force Fund are continuously appropriated to the Oregon Department
22 of Administrative Services for the purposes of the Oregon School Facilities Task Force es-
23 tablished under section 1 of this 2009 Act.**

24 “**SECTION 5. (1) Section 4 of this 2009 Act is repealed on January 2, 2012.**

25 “**(2) Any moneys remaining in the Oregon School Facilities Task Force Fund on January
26 2, 2012, that are unexpended, unobligated and not subject to any conditions shall revert to
27 the General Fund.**

28 “**SECTION 6. If House Bill 2012 becomes law, the lottery ending balance, as defined in
29 section 1, chapter __, Oregon Laws 2009 (Enrolled House Bill 2012), for the 2007-2009
30 biennium shall be allocated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services for the
31 purpose of funding:**

32 “**(1) The Oregon School Facilities Task Force, as established under section 1 of this 2009
33 Act; and**

34 “**(2) The study conducted by the Oregon School Facilities Task Force, as described in
35 section 2 of this 2009 Act.**

1 **“SECTION 7. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$35,000**
2 **is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for payment of**
3 **expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Devel-**
4 **opment Fund to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services for the Oregon School**
5 **Facilities Task Force established under section 1 of this 2009 Act.”.**

6 In line 25, delete “5” and insert “8”.
